- Drinking Water Asset Management

Due to the 'excellence approach', Blue Drop Status in only awarded to Municipalities that score greater than 95% in all of the aforementioned criteria. To this end Msunduzi has now joined an elite list of Municipalities and further confirms that our drinking water, rates amongst the best in the country.
