Only one Site Inspection Meeting will be held. No tender shall be accepted from tenderers who do not attend the above Meeting. No tender documents shall be issued at the Site Inspection Meeting.

Only tenderers achieving a minimum threshold of 70% or higher for functionality in the first stage shall be considered in the second stage, where the 90/10 Preferential Points System shall thereafter apply.
