Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

**Tender Validity Period:** Ninety (90) days commencing from the closing date of tender.

**Tender Evaluation / Adjudication Criteria:** The Evaluation and Adjudication of the tender will be done in line with the Msunduzi Municipality's approved Supply Chain and Preferential Procurement Policies on the **80/20 Points System**. The Adjudication Criteria will be as per the tender document.
